

Drs H.A. (Huibert) Haccoû (1950)

Huibert Haccoû is associate professor at the School of Environmental Planning & Building of the Saxion Universities of Professional Education in Deventer in the Netherlands where he teaches Urban and Regional planning.

He is founder and principal consultant of Haccoû-Consultancy and Design based in the Netherlands. He provides consultancy services to private and public, local, regional and (inter) national planning agencies.

In this capacity he developed and implements as programme manager the international research program of the Habiforum Foundation, creating an international network of expertise on multifunctional and intensive land use.

He is a member of the editorial board of NOVA TERRA, a quarterly magazine on innovative use of space.

Trained as a political scientist and economist (Free University Amsterdam) his career started in the civil service. In various functions at the central-, the provincial- and city government level, he acquired a broad understanding of the larger context in which growth, and development planning occur. He changed to a private consultancy and engineering firm and was assigned to national -and international projects as a consultant for strategic public policy making and as process manager in the field of spatial and environmental planning.
